Trauma Care for Vulnerable Populations:
Challenges and Opportunities for the
Emergency Nurse Practitioner

Dr. Lawson began her career in academia in 2001 when she joined the University of South Alabama College of Nursing as an assistant professor. She rose to the rank of professor and served as Associate Dean for Clinical Affairs while there. Dr. Lawson received her BSN, MSN, and DNP degrees from the University of South Alabama. She is an expert in the design, implementation, and evaluation of nursing curricula. She has been recognized for her excellence in teaching and developing successful nursing education programs from within and beyond the college arena. She has maintained a successful clinical practice as a nurse practitioner for almost two decades. She has expertise in caring for vulnerable populations and creating educational programs that facilitate nurse practitioner practice in rural and underserved areas.


